Admission is granted on a competitive basis after a comprehensive review of application materials, CSCA (China Scholastic Competency Assessment) scores, the supervisor's assessment, and interview results.

## IMPORTANT DATE

- ❖ **Date of Application:** November 20<sup>th</sup>, 2025 to June 30<sup>th</sup>, 2026.
- ❖ **Date of School:** The end of August to the beginning of September, 2026
- ❖ **Date of Registration:** September 1<sup>st</sup>, 2026; The specific registration time will be notified on the official website.



1. Applicants must be non-Chinese citizens with a valid ordinary-type passport and in good health both mentally and physically.

**Note:** According to Nationality Law and the regulations of the Ministry of Education of China, applicants who have international nationality at birth, one or both parents is Chinese citizen and are applying to Shanghai University as international students must present valid passport or citizenship documents attained before April 30, 2022 and proof of renunciation of Chinese nationality, along with proof of residence abroad of at least 2 years between April 30, 2022 and April 30, 2026(9 months of residence abroad per year may be considered as one year).

Residents of mainland China, Hong Kong, Macau and Taiwan who have emigrated to other countries and are applying to Shanghai University as international students must present valid passport or citizenship documents attained before April 30, 2022 and proof of their renunciation of Chinese nationality, along with proof of residence abroad of at least 2 years between April 30, 2022 and April 30, 2026(9 months of residence abroad per year may be considered as one year).

Relevant applicants are required to provide supporting documents such as birth certificates, entry and exit seals records, certificate of renunciation and Commitment Letter for Entry Exit Information (You can download at <https://apply.shu.edu.cn>). Those who fail to pass the nationality status review will automatically lose the eligibility to apply and any subsequent admission results they may obtain.

## 2. Language Proficiency

### 2.1 Chinese-taught programs, HSK certificates within two years are required.

(HSK refers to Chinese Proficiency Test. You can find information on: [www.chinesetest.cn](http://www.chinesetest.cn)):

### The following types of applicants are exempt from taking the English proficiency tests

- ✓ The previous degree is fully taught in English. The language statement must be on official headed paper, and must be the original document.

**Note: The three majors of Ullisboa College are taught in both Chinese and English. The language requirements are HSK 5 above 180, and IELTS 5 or TOEFL 60 or other internationally recognized English proficiency tests with scores of the same level.**

### 3. Academic Requirement

3.1 Be an academically excellent holder of high school diploma or its equivalent with GPA 3.0 or above (Note: 4-Point GPA System);

Graduates-to-be who have not yet obtained their graduation certificate at the time of application are required to provide pre-graduation certificate issued by school or college and Commitment Letter (can be downloaded in <https://apply.shu.edu.cn> ) to demonstrate that the applicant has the ability to graduate successfully and obtain the certificate before July 31, 2026.

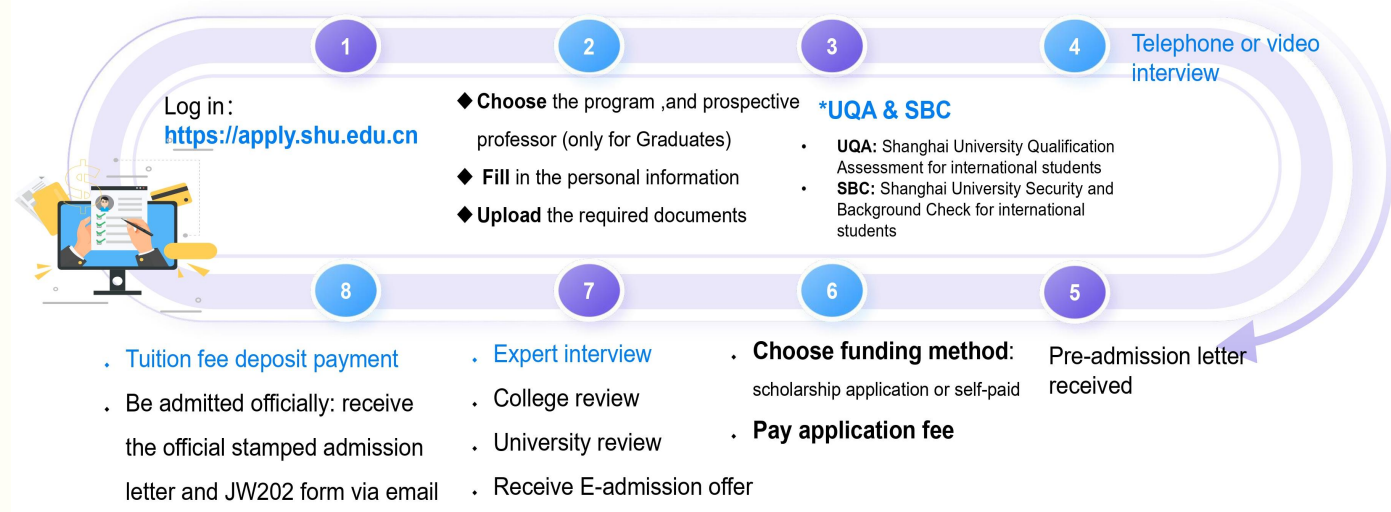
3.2 For Science and Engineering programs, applicants are qualified in mathematics and physics in high school. Some programs also require computer programming courses record;

For Economics and Management programs, applicants are qualified in mathematics in high school;

For Arts programs, applicants must have related academic background and are required to submit the portfolio (such as paintings, story scripts, short movies, etc.).

## 2. Shanghai University Security and Background Check (SBC) for International Students

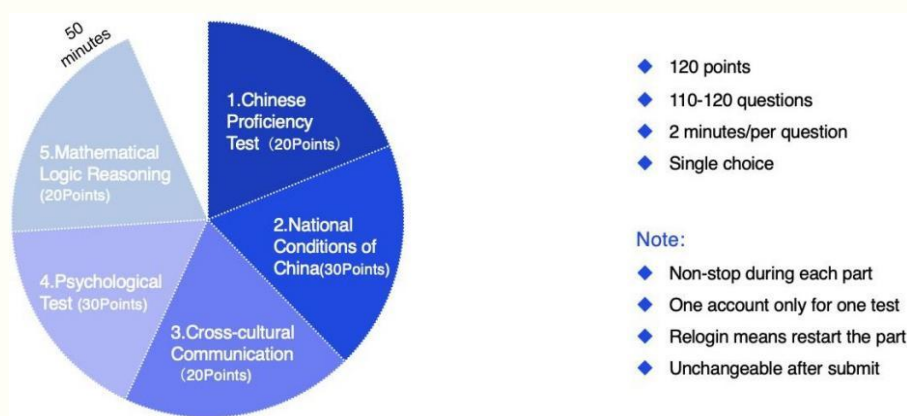

Please note that you must answer truthfully for verification, and the results will be put on record by Shanghai University.

## 3. University Qualification Assessment(UQA) for International Students

3.1 Only individual international applicants for degree programs are required to take UQA, which aims to evaluate whether an international student is eligible for degree programs in Shanghai University.

## 4. About Interview

An interview (AI Interview included) will be arranged. The format will be notified via email. The interview is expected to last for 10-15 minutes, and the language used depends on the language of instruction of your degree program.

## 5. Tuition Deposit Payment

All applicants of degree programs must pay the tuition deposit (One-year or half a year tuition fee) after receiving the E-admission notice within 20 working days. If the payment is not completed after 20 days, it would be regarded as giving up. # Application Materials

All uploaded documents should be well prepared in PDF files or Images

### ❖ ID Photo

The passport-size photo (one-inch, 219\*413) should be taken within the last six months, bareheaded, full-faced with blue-color background; the photo is required to submit as JPG image less than 100kb.

❖ **Information Page of Ordinary Passport**

A clear copy of your valid ordinary passport with your name, photo, birth date, place of birth, date of issue, date of expiry; **Visa page** is required for applicants who are currently in China or not in their home country.

❖ **Scan of China Scholastic Competency Assessment (CSCA) transcript.**

Note: If you have not yet received your CSCA official score report during the application stage, you can upload a screenshot of the registration for the text as temporary document. Once the official score report is available, please be sure to send it via email to the program coordinator before the deadline. The coordinator will assist you in completing the upload to the online application system. Scholarship applicants must provide the transcript before May 15; self-funded applicants must submit it before June 30.

❖ **Selfie Video**

Applicants should submit a video including self-introduction and study plan in China.

avi, mov, or mp4 less than 50MB are accepted. The language of the video should be consistent with the language of the program you are applying for (English or Chinese).

❖ **Highest Degree Certificate and Official Transcripts**

Graduates-to-be should present an original or notarized copy of pre-graduation certificate, and official transcripts of all courses completed by the time of application.

❖ **Language Proficiency Certificate**

If the score sheet is not available at the time of application, applicants may upload a screen shot of your scores. But the original score sheet is required when registration.

❖ **Statement of Financial Support** (You can download at <https://apply.shu.edu.cn/application/index> )

❖ **Personal Statement (including study plan and research proposal in China)**

Written in English or Chinese (according to the teaching language of the program), including research achievements so far (e.g. title and abstracts of graduation thesis or published paper), reasons of choosing SHU, study and research plan, future career plan, etc.

❖ **Certificate of No Criminal Record**

For any applicants who can not get the Certificate of No Criminal Record at home country, please sign the No criminal record Commitment with Shanghai University.

❖ **Other (Refer to Departmental standards)**

Applicants for art majors should provide relevant artworks (painting, audios or videos).

### About Tuition Deposit Payment

The self-paid applicants of degree programs must pay the tuition fees deposit when receiving the receiving the E-admission notice within 20 working days. If the payment is not completed after 20 days, it would be regarded as giving up.

**Payment Standard:** One-year or half a year tuition fee.

- 1) **Online payment in the SHU International Students Application System:** only bank cards issued outside China are currently supported.
- 2) **Bank transfer using bank cards issued within China:** Payment in CNY can be made via online or mobile banking using bank accounts issued within China.

## 2.Payment policy

All self-paid applicants must pay the tuition fees deposit in advance. The following types of students can be exempted from paying the tuition deposit:

**a)Scholarship students** (including Chinese Government Scholarship, International Chinese Language Teachers Scholarship, Shanghai Government Scholarship, Shanghai University Scholarship, and CCN foundation program scholarship). Please log in to the application system, click "Tuition Deposit Payment", and upload the screenshot of the scholarship confirmation email.

**b)Students recommended by partner institutions of Shanghai University.**

## 3.Refund Policy

The prepaid tuition fee may be refunded under the following circumstances (**refunds are limited to bank accounts within China only**):

- a. Applicants who submit written confirmation of withdrawal within 30 days of successful payment (based on the date the school receives the funds) and no later than the registration date;
- b. The school cancels the applicant's admitted major;
- c. The student's visa application fails due to reasons beyond personal control (a formal official proof from the embassy or consulate is required, and a written application must be submitted before the registration deadline);
- d. The student is unable to enroll normally due to force majeure factors such as earthquakes or war (a written application is required);

For those unable to come to the school to study due to other reasons, a written application must be submitted, and 90% of the prepaid tuition fee will be refunded.

## 4. Refund Procedures

**For applicants who meet the Refund Policies listed above**

Fill in the refund application form (refer to the template), and then submit to International Students Admissions Office with the following:

## Appendix 3: Introduction of China Scholastic Competency Assessment

### I. What is the CSCA?

The full name is the **China Scholastic Competency Assessment**.  
The abbreviation is **CSCA** (China Scholastic Competency Assessment).  
All information should be based on the official website of  
CSCA: **www.csca.cn**

(the official website will be launched in October 2025).

### II. Test Subjects

There are 5 subjects, taking a "mandatory + elective" mode. Divided into two categories: professional Chinese and basic subjects:

Professional Chinese	Chinese Language for Liberal arts	Chinese	90 minutes	100 multiple-choice questions

	Physics (elective)	Chinese/English	60 minute	48 multiple-choice questions
	Chemistry (elective)	Chinese/English	60 minute	48 multiple-choice questions

#### Important Notes:

- Mathematics** is a **mandatory subject** for everyone.
- Students applying for Chinese-taught majors (excluding BA of Chinese Language) must take the professional Chinese exam according to their major direction (liberal arts/science).
- Students applying for English-taught undergraduate majors and BA of Chinese Language do not need to take the professional Chinese exam.
- Students applying for majors in science, engineering, agriculture, and medicine usually need to take at least one subject from physics and chemistry.

### III. Test Time and Format

- The first Global exam: **December 21, 2025**.
- Starting from 2026, the exam will be held **5 times a year**, in **January, March, April, June, and December**.
- Test format: Home-based online exam** is the main method, and offline test centers are set up in some countries (Vietnam and Thailand will be the first to establish offline test centers in 2025).



### IV. Registration and Fees

- Registration time:** It is expected to open the registration for the first exam in November 2025.
- Registration method:** Mainly through the **online registration** on the CSCA official website: [www.csca.cn](http://www.csca.cn).
- Test fees:**
  - ◆ Single subject: 450 RMB;
  - ◆ Two or more subjects: 700 RMB
- Payment methods:** Support Alipay, WeChat, UnionPay, VISA, MasterCard, etc.

### V. Score Report

- All subjects use a 100-point system.**
- Score release:**
  - Online/Computer-based exam:** within 7 working days after the exam;
  - Paper-based exam:** within 14 working days after the exam

### VI. Important Attention

- CSCA scores are required materials for applying to undergraduate programs at our university. If you do not have a score report during the application stage, you can submit a registration screenshot first and then submit the formal score report **before June 30th**.
- CSCA scores are an important reference for admission and scholarship evaluation. The major of admission will be decided based on your comprehensive performance in each subject.
