Handbook for New International Students Shanghai University (2026-2027)



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D1 Before departure

Welcome to study at Shanghai University. Before departure, you should inquire with the Chinese Embassy in your home country for a valid study visa. It is your responsibility to make sure that the visa is sufficient to cover the entire duration of your stay. Please read the relevant matters in the manual carefully, and keep in touch with Shanghai University.

1.1. Laws and Regulations

The behavior of international students in China will be subject to the relevant laws of the People's Republic of China, local regulations, and university rules and regulations. In order to better understand Chinese laws during your study and avoid incidents that violate Chinese laws due to the ignorance of the law, please know and abide by the relevant laws and regulations.

A. Laws and Regulations for Foreigners in China

(1)According to Constitution of the People's Republic of China and Exit and Entry Administration Law of the People's Republic of China, the legitimate rights and interests of foreigners in China shall be protected by laws. Foreigners in China shall abide by the Chinese laws, and shall not endanger China's national security, harm public interests and disrupt social and public order. According to Exit and Entry Administration Law of the People's Republic of China, foreigners in China shall register their accommodation on time and comply with the identification inspection of public security organs.

(2)Provisions on the Administration of Religious Activities of Aliens within the Territory of the People's Republic of China

The People's Republic of China respects the freedom of religious belief of aliens within Chinese territory, and protects and administrates the religious activities of aliens within Chinese territory in accordance with law. Aliens may participate in religious activities at lawfully registered Buddhist monasteries, Taoist temples, mosques, churches within Chinese territory according to their own religious belief.Missionary work or religious gatherings on campus are prohibited.

(3)Law of the People's Republic of China on Penalties for Administration of Public Security.The person who disturbs public order, endangers public safety, infringes on the rights of person and property or hampers social administration, which is harmful to the society and which, according to the provisions of the Criminal Law of the People's Republic of China, constitutes a crime, shall be investigated for criminal responsibility according to the law. If such an act is not serious enough for criminal punishment, the public security organ shall impose on him a penalty for administration of public security according to this Law.

(4)Anti-Drug Law of the People's Republic of China

This Law is enacted for the purpose of preventing and punishing criminal offences related to narcotic drugs, protecting the health of citizens both in body and in mind and maintaining social order. For the purposes of this Law, narcotic drugs include opium, heroin, methylaniline(ice), morphine, marijuana, cocaine and other narcotic and psychotropic substances that are addictive and are kept under control according to State regulations.Article 59 Where a person commits any of the following acts, which constitutes a crime, he shall be investigated for criminal responsibility according to law;

if the case is not serious enough to constitute a crime, a penalty for administration of public security shall be imposed on him according to law:

- 1)smuggling, selling, transporting or manufacturing narcotic drugs;
- 2)illegally possessing narcotic drugs;
- 3)illegally cultivating the mother plants of narcotic drugs;
- 4)illegally trafficking in, transporting, carrying or possessing the seeds or seedlings of the mother plants of narcotic drugs, which are not inactivated;
- 5)illegally imparting the methods for manufacturing narcotic or psychotropic substances or the chemical materials that can easily be transformed into narcotic drugs;
- 6)compelling, or instigating another person to ingest or inject drugs, or luring or inveigling him into doing so;
- 7)providing narcotic drugs to another person.

B.Shanghai University Student Management Regulations

(1)Students shall perform the following obligations in accordance with the law during their schooling: abide by laws and regulations, and abide by the school management system and the students' code of conduct, etc.

(2)For students who violate the laws, regulations and disciplines, the university can give corresponding criticism education or disciplinary sanctions in accordance with the "Regulations on Disciplinary Punishments for Students of Shanghai University", which will affect the evaluation of the scholarships and student status.

(3)The international students shall abide by the Exit and Entry Administration Law of the People's Republic of China. For students who need to continue study in Shanghai University or extend the study period when the

residence permit expires shall make residence permit extensions at the Shanghai Administration of Entry and Exit Administration Bureau.

(4)Shanghai University insists on the separation of education and religion. No organization or individual may conduct religious activities on the campus.

1.2.Visa application

A. X1 visa

X1 visa is issued to students who study in China for more than 180 days.

Holders of X1 visa must register at Exit-Entry Administration Bureau within 30 days after arrival to change the visa status into Residence Permit Please have an access to Chinese Embassy in your home country online for application information.

B.X2 visa

DQ form is issued to students who study in China for less than 180 days.

Please have an access to Chinese Embassy in your home country online for application information.

C.Other types of visa

International students who received visa-free entry shall not apply for a study class residence permit or X2 visa and should leave China prior to their visa-free validity expires before applying for a X1 or X2 visa to enter China again.

1.3.Accommodation

Shanghai University provides on-campus accommodation for international students.Please make a reservation based on the notice sent by e-mail. Since the rooms are limited, it's highly suggested that students rent the apartment off-campus in advance.

1.3.1.On-campus dormitory

On-campus rooms have been equipped with beds, bedclothes, a desk, a closet, an air-conditioner, Campus network,Hot water, etc.There are shared kitchens, washing machines, dryers and hot-water machines in the public area. Each building are equipped with smoke alarm,monitoring equipment, etc.

1.3.1.1.Facilities and price

A.Baoshan campus

Two dormitories, Building V and W, The dormitories offer 24-hour front desk services.

1.3.1.2.Room Reservation

A.Degree program students, exchange students and language students

For admitted students,the reservation can be applied after receiving the reservation notice by e-mail from Shanghai University.

B.Short-term program students

For short-term students, please contact directly with the program manager who works in College of International Education.

Note:

If students want to cancel their reservation, please inform us via email at least 4 weeks in advance. Or the deposit will not be returned. Please indicate in the email subject:Dormitory Cancellation+Name+Program.

1.3.1.3 Payment

Payment due date: Students can make payment at the time they check in.

Payment method: Pay by credit card.

Notes:

a)If students pay by international credit card or debit card issued by Chinese bank branches abroad, service fee will be charged.

b)As for long-term students, they need to pay the fee in one lump sum for one semester.If they check out earlier, they need to submit a written application 1 month in advance. When the logistics department received the application,the residual room charge will be returned to their Chinese bank account.

c) As for short-term students,they need to pay the fee in one lump sum.If they check out earlier, the residual room charge will not be returned.

1.3.2.Off-campus accommodation

Due to the limited dormitory room, Shanghai University cannot guarantee that all students make a reservation successfully. If the reservation is not successful, please find a safe and reliable rental room or hotel before arrival in Shanghai.

A.According to Law of the PRC on Entry and Exit of Aliens and the rules governing the implementation of the law, foreigners shall register their residence in China within 24 hours of arrival.

If you are staying at a hotel or hostel,the staff there will automatically do it for you. If you ask,they will give you the form. Please make sure they stamp it with the hotel or hostel' seal.

If you are renting an apartment or staying with your friends, you need to go to the local police station yourself. The landlord should bring along the Certificate of Residence, Certificate of Housing,lease contract,and their ID card.The student should also bring their passport.

You can also finish the registration on self-service residential registration system. The online registration procedures are as below:



Step 1: Login the website:https://gaj.sh.gov.cn/crj/24hr/web/zcbd/login?relogin=true

Step 2: choose the ID type and upload the ID and portrait photo.

Step 3: Fill in the address,arrival date and departure date, tick the letter of commitment and submit it.

Step 4: check the verification result and print the E-registration Form of Temporary Residence.

Tips: If the information fails to pass the automatic verification due to incomplete information, it will be handled manually, please be patient. If there is an urgent need to obtain a temporary residence registration form, you can still go to the window of the police station to submit written materials for declaration.

B.Reminders for off-campus Accommodation

a) Read items in the contract carefully before signing any contract, if you are not clear enough about the contract please do not sign it or it means you have accepted all the provisions in the contract.

b) If the contract only in Chinese version and you can not understand the provisions in the contract, you can consult our office for that. Please do not sign any contract without fully understanding the contract lest being cheated.

c) If you have any doubt about the housing agency, please consult our staff in office. Do not pay anything to the agency before signing the contract and do not believe in any oral promises of staff in housing agency.

d) After signing the contract and completing the payment, please ask for the formal invoice from housing agency.

1.4.Packing tips

1.4.1.Emergency envelope

In case of emergency, it is good to have extra copies of important documents. You should consider making an ‘emergency envelope’ containing copies of your passport ID page and Visa page(s), insurance information, emergency contact information, tuition receipts, acceptance/admission forms, credit card/bank information, and any important medical documents.

It is also a good idea to back all of these documents up online on a cloud server or your email that is not blocked in China.

1.4.2.Customs Inspection

Please search online for the regulations of China Customs regarding the carrying of items across the border. Meanwhile, please note that individuals entering China are not allowed to carry more than 20,000 RMB in cash or the equivalent amount of foreign currency.

1.4.3.Medication

Carry all prescription medication with a copy of all written prescriptions in your carry-on bag in case of inspection. Check that all medications are allowed in China before departure.

Bring all prescription medication or contact lenses you may need during your stay in China as some specific medicines or brands may not be available.

1.4.4.Cash preparation

Please be noted that the first month of scholarship

payment of living expenses will be slightly delayed, so please bring one-month living expenses (about 4000 RMB). If students are self-supported, please prepare enough cash.

1.4.5.Others

Purchase transformers & adapters ahead of time (Domestic electricity in China is 220 volts/50Hz.)

Chinese standard socket used in China is shown here, please bring your own voltage conversion equi). Students have been suggested bring at least 20 passport size photos and traveling wash bag.



1.5. Medical Examination and Insurance

All international students studying in mainland China must purchase a comprehensive insurance scheme, as valid insurance certificate is indispensable for international students to register for the new semester.

If you are in China or expected to arrive in China to register this semester: You can purchase the insurance by yourself (800 yuan per year). Even if your scholarship items contain the insurance fee, you still need to purchase insurance by yourself first, and later the school will return the insurance premium to your bank account in China.

If you are not in China and choose to register online: it

is not a must for you to purchase insurance currently, since this insurance does not cover medical expenses outside mainland China. You can choose to purchase it after your arrival in China.

International students studying in China for less than three months can choose to purchase own local insurance before coming to China. Students who have purchased international insurance in home country, please provide proof of insurance when registering.

International students who study for more than three months (including three months) must purchase insurance products in China.

1.6.Fee Payment

All the self-funded applicants for degree programs must pay at least half to a year's tuition fees before registration. New students who prepaid only half-year tuition fees must pay off the remaining tuition fees on the day of registration. Payment receipts (including tuition and registration fee) are necessary materials for new students to go through the registration procedures.

A.Payment Method

1)Online payment in the SHU International Students Application System: only bank cards issued outside China are currently supported.

2)Bank transfer using bank cards issued within

China: Payment in CNY can be made via online or mobile banking using bank accounts issued within China.

B. Refund Policy

The prepaid tuition fee may be refunded under

the following circumstances (**refunds are**

limited to bank accounts within China only):

- 1). Applicants who submit written confirmation of withdrawal within 30 days of successful payment (based on the date the school receives the funds) and no later than the registration date;

2).The school cancels the applicant's admitted major;

3). The student's visa application fails due to reasons beyond personal control (a formal official proof from the embassy or consulate is required, and a written application must be submitted before the registration deadline);

4).The student is unable to enroll normally due to force majeure factors such as earthquakes or war (a written application is required);

For those unable to come to the school to study due to other reasons, a written application must be submitted, and 90% of the prepaid tuition fee will be refunded.

C.Refund Procedures

For applicants who meet the Refund Policies listed above

Fill in the refund application form (refer to the template), and then submit to International Students Admissions Office with the following:

- Copy of passport
- Copy of Chinese Bank account information
- Copy of Opening Bank information
- Copy of Payment receipt
- Others (visa rejection statement from the embassy or consulate etc.)

Please note that it takes at least 90 working days to deal with the refund process.

1.7.Shanghai Entry Reminder

Please make an online appointment for a medical examination in advance.
(the medical examination report will take 4 working days to obtain).

As the medical examination report will be required to apply for the residence permit for study, please make sure to obtain the medical examination report before applying for the residence permit.

4.Visa Coordinator Confirmation: insurance purchase status, issuance of visa application letter.

5.Student ID card : to Informational Office to make your student ID card by the paper Application Form.

3.3.Change of VISA status (if needed)

According to The Exit and Entry Administration Law of the People's Republic of China, foreign residents who wish to study in China for less than 180 days are able to apply for X2 visa with single entry. If foreign residents wish to study in China more than 180 days should apply for a study type residence permit.

According to the Law of the People's Republic of China on Control of the Entry and Exit of Aliens, foreign residents who enter China with a valid X2 visa may apply

for a re-entry visa and visa extension if necessary. The maximum valid period of the visa is 180 days.

4.1.Student card

The student ID can only be used as a proof of the holder (student) himself/herself and should not be lent to others.

Please go to the office for student card at Information Technology Office to take a photo and get your card. (Yanchang campus: Xingjian Building; Baoshan campus: room 605, Building D ; Jiading campus: Room 116, Administration Building)

The student card can be used:
A.in cafeterias; (Students can top up their cards in the first cafeteria of Yanchang Campus and all the cafeterias of Baoshan Campus, or via Alipay or Wechat Pay.)
B.as dorm pass;
C.at hospital on campus;
D.in libraries.

It is free for the first application for student card; 20 RMB will be charged for a new card if the card is missing.

4.2.Internet

Free Wi-Fi is provided in the student dorms. Students will log in using their SHU internet log-in details. Cable internet is also available.

Legislation and projects initiated by the Chinese government attempt to regulate the Internet in Mainland China.

In order to access many websites, students need to use a Virtual Private Network (VPN). VPNs are private networks established by creating a tunnel secured by various tunneling protocols (e.g., PPTP, L2TP, IPSec, SSTP). There are free VPN services students can find online. Without a VPN, Google (including google mail), YouTube, Facebook, Instagram, and many other popular websites will not be accessible.

After student card is activated, students can log in via : <http://services.shu.edu.cn/> with the student number as the user name and the passport number as the initial password. The password can be reset after log in.

Due to the network firewall, some foreign websites may not be accessible in China. In order to access many websites, international students can download “VPN” on mobile and log on to foreign websites. You can also buy a monthly VPN service from the app.

4.3.SIM Card

China Mobile, China Unicom and China Telecom are the three biggest mobile communication companies in China. Students can buy SIM card with passport at any outlets nearby. The China Mobile company will provide on-site services on the new student's registration day.

4.4. Bank account

All students studying in China for more than three months are required to obtain a Chinese savings bank card, with the cost of card issuance determined by the bank's regulations. It is recommended that students apply in advance for a savings card from Bank of China online to facilitate the card application process after arriving in China.

On the day of registration, the Qilian Mountain Road Branch of Bank of China in Shanghai will provide on-site account opening services (passport and visa page copies are required). If you need to open an account, please follow the steps below to make an appointment:



Download the “China Entry” app and complete the preliminary registration online — register using your personal email, click on “Appointment for Account Opening” — select “Identity Type” (e.g., Foreigner) — upload a photo of your ID and fill in basic information — choose the branch for account opening (please select “China” , “Shanghai City” , “Baoshan District” , “Qilian

Mountain Road Branch of Bank of China in Shanghai”) — submit your appointment application.

05 Scholarship Issues

5.1.Scholarship annual review

As per the Scholarship regulations, scholarship-funded students who study for over one year in China should undergo an annual review evaluating their study attitude,class attendance, daily performance, awards and student conduct, etc. Those who pass the evaluation will maintain next year's scholarship. For those who fail in the review, scholarship status will be suspended for one year or permanently depending on the outcome of the review.

The annual scholarship review is always taken from the end of March to May.

5.2.Registration and Monthly Allowance

- 1)Scholarship-funded students shall receive their monthly living allowance after registration.
- 2)The living allowance is granted based on semesterly registration and monthly registration.
- 3)For students with scholarship including the stipend, they will receive the stipend from the personal scholarship account after registration on prescribed time.The payment will commence from the month of September after registration. Students who register before the 15th (inclusive) of the registration month will receive full living stipend for that month. Those who register after the 15th will receive only half of the stipend.

For full scholarship students enrolled in autumn semester, the first month's living stipend will be sent with delay because of the complicated procedures in Bank. Please prepare money for the first month's expenses in China (about RMB 3000~4000). To ensure the distribution of living expenses successfully, please provide the correct bank account information before September 30th.

5.3.Changes in student status

Changes in student status may include suspension, withdrawal, change of programme, transfer to another university and the extension of study length, etc.

In principle, the Chinese government scholarship-funded students cannot change major, transfer to another university or prolong the length of study. On special condition, the institution who sends this student should apply to China Scholarship Council. Those who change major, transfer to another university, or prolong the length of study will be deprived of the rights to enjoy the scholarship.

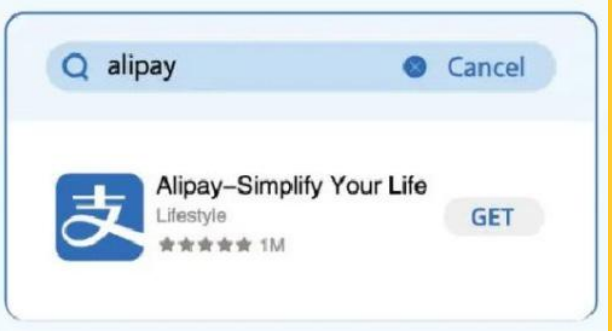
