Non-Chinese citizens with a valid foreign passport; graduated from high school or above; between 18 and 55 years old. Guarantee statement should be submitted if less than 18 years old.

English proficiency:

IELTS (A) 6.0 or TOEFL IBT 80 or above; Other internationally recognized English proficiency tests with scores of the same level and provide proof of certificates; *The following types of applicants are exempt from taking the TOEFL or IELTS:*

- Native speakers of English;
- The previous degree is fully taught in English.
